# 발간사

---

서울대학교 중앙도서관은 1980년부터 서지 데이터베이스 구축을 시작하여 현재 도서관에서 소장하고 있는 모든 자료는 도서관 홈페이지에서 검색이 가능합니다. 다만, 도서관 전산화 이전에 카드 목록으로 관리해 오던 고문헌은 카드에 수록한 정보를 전산화하다 보니 서명이나 저자명과 같은 기본 정보만을 데이터베이스화하였고, 이는 연구자의 자료 접근성을 제한하는 약점이 있습니다.

또한 우리 도서관 소장 고문헌은 영어, 독일어, 프랑스어, 중국어, 일본어는 물론 라틴어나 희랍어, 아랍어 등 특수 언어의 외국어 자료가 상당하여, 서명과 같은 기본 정보에서 표기 오류가 적지 않게 발견되었습니다. 이에 우리 도서관은 2014년도부터 교육부의 지원을 받아 추진한 경성제대 컬렉션 및 근대 기록문화재 보존관리 사업의 일환으로 소장 고문헌의 서지 정보 수정과 보완을 시작하였습니다.

2018년에는 경성제국대학 부속도서관 장서 가운데 군사학 분야의 서양서 단행본을 대상으로 서지 정보를 보완하였으며, 이번에 그 결과물인 도서목록을 발간합니다. 도서목록은 자료 정보가 인터넷을 통하여 유통되기 전인 아날로그 시절의 산물로 오늘날에는 거의 작성하지 않으나, 한정된 주제나 특정 성격의 자료를 일람하는 데에는 여전히 유용한 도구입니다.

이번에 우리 도서관이 간행한 도서목록은 일제강점기 한반도 내 최고 교육기관인 경성제국대학에서 수집한 장서라는, 대상 자료의 성격을 바탕으로 특정 주제의 장서 구성과 형성 배경을 비롯하여 당시의 학문이나 지식 경향까지도 파악해 볼 수 있는 좋은 기초 연구 자료가 될 것입니다.

우리 도서관은 향후 서지 보완이 진행되는 정도에 따라 수시로 주제 분야별 도서목록을 발간할 예정입니다. 아무쪼록 이번에 발간한 도서목록이 관련 분야의 연구 활성화에 기여할 수 있기를 바랍니다.

## Preface

---

Seoul National University Library started constructing a bibliographic database since 1980. Currently, all resources in Seoul National University Library can be searched in Seoul National University Library website. The information of old documents collected before 1945 were, however, entered into the database with the basic information including their titles and authors, causing limited accessibility for researchers, because online cataloguing was done on the basis of card catalogs before the library system was computerized.

Moreover, there were some errors found in the basic information such as book titles of old documents written in various languages including English, German, French, Chinese, Japanese and even in rare languages such as Greek, Latin and Arabic.

Under these circumstances, Seoul National University Library, under the support of the Ministry of Education, embarked upon the correction and supplementation of the bibliographic data of old documents and books, as part of the Preservation Management Project of Keijo Imperial University Collection and the Modern Written Heritages.

In 2018, the library supplemented the bibliographic data of the books on military and naval sciences which previously belonged to Keijo Imperial University Library. This bibliography is the outcome of the project. Although bibliographies are considered to be products of the analog era when information was not distributed via the Internet and are rarely compiled these days, we believe they remain to be useful for perusing materials on a specific topic or of a certain type.

*The Bibliography of Keijo Imperial University Library*, published by Seoul National University Library, comprises information on the collection owned by Keijo Imperial University, the top higher educational institution in the Korean peninsula during the Japanese colonial era. Therefore, it will serve as a useful basic research data for researchers who seek to understand the composition of the collection on certain topics, the formative background of the collection, as well as academic and learning trends of the colonial era.

Seoul National University Library will continue to issue bibliographies classified by

subject fields as the correction and supplementation project proceeds. We hope that this bibliography will contribute to further research in the relevant fields of study.

## 일러두기

---

이 도서목록은 서울대학교 중앙도서관이 소장하고 있는 경성제국대학 부속도서관 장서 가운데 군사학 분야의 서양서 단행본을 대상으로 작성하였다. 이 도서목록에는 모두 121종 158권에 해당하는 도서의 서지 정보가 실려 있다.

경성제국대학 부속도서관은 장서를 분류하는데 ‘화한서분류표’(和漢書分類表)와 ‘서양서분류표’(Classification of European Books)를 사용하였다. 화한서분류표는 동양서를 분류하는데 사용하였고, 서양서분류표는 서양서를 분류하는데 사용하였다. 서양서분류표는 서양서 단행본을 22개의 주제로 분류하였으며, A부터 X까지 24개 알파벳 가운데 숫자와 혼동되는 I와 O를 제외한 22개의 알파벳을 사용하여 주제를 표기하였다. A는 총류(General Works), B는 철학(Philosophy), C는 종교(Religion) 등으로 주제를 나타내었다. 이 책자는 그 중에서 분류기호가 X로 시작하는 군사학(Military & Naval Sciences)에 해당하는 서양서 단행본의 도서목록이다.

경성제국대학 부속도서관은 대(大) 주제를 나타내는 22개의 알파벳(main classes)에 세 자리 숫자를 더하여 세부 주제를 분류하였다. 예를 들어 X500은 해군학, X900은 적십자를 의미한다. 서양서분류표 상에는 군사학 분야에 총 5개의 주제 분류기호가 사용되었다. 그러나 듀이십진분류법(DDC)처럼 주제의 대분류, 중분류, 소분류가 명확하게 구분되지는 않는다.

이 도서목록의 목차는 서양서분류표의 군사학 분야 분류표대로 배열하였으며, 당시의 범주 구성을 그대로 차용하였다. 당시의 분류 방식을 오늘날에 맞게 변용할 것인가도 고려해 보았지만, 사실상 있는 그대로 보여주는 편이 당시의 분류체계를 이해하는데 도움이 될 것 같아 한글로 병기한 것 외에는 분류표를 따로 수정하지는 않았다. 또한 당시 분류하였던 방식 그대로 책을 나열하였다. 분류는 당대의 학문 경향에 영향을 받으므로, 오늘날 이 책을 분류할 경우 재분류가 불가피하다. 이 또한 날 것 그대로 드러내는 편이 당시의 학문 경향을 파악하는데 도움이 될 것 같아 분류를 새로 하지는 않았다.


동일 주제로 분류한 책은 당시 청구기호순으로 배열하였다. 경성제국대학 부속도서관의 청구기호는 알파벳 한 자리와 숫자 세 자리를 결합한 분류기호에 수입순 번호(도서관에 입수된 순서대로 번호를 부여)와 책의 권·호 정보를 결합하여 구성하였다. 또한 특수한 형태의

자료는 분류기호 앞에 별치기호를 부여하였다. 예를 들어, 귀중도서로 지정된 책은 ‘貴’, 크기가 30cm 이상인 책은 ‘大’와 같은 한자를 활용한 별치기호를 부여하였다. 다시 말해 이 도서목록은 현재 고문헌자료실 서가에 배열되어 있는 순서대로 구성하였다고 이해하면 될 것이다. 다음은 청구기호의 한 예이다.

다음으로, 도서목록에 실려 있는 책의 서지 정보를 설명하고자 한다. 이 책은 도서관의 목록 정보를 기본으로 작성하였으며, 이와 별도로 책을 이해하는데 필요하다고 판단한 부가 정보인 책의 면수(또는 권수), 크기, 총서명(또는 개별서명)도 함께 게재하였다. 다음은 이 도서목록에 실려 있는 서지 정보의 한 예이다.

# Introduction

---

This is a bibliography of Western books on military & naval sciences from Keijo Imperial University Library Collection owned by Seoul National University Library. This bibliography comprises bibliographic information of 121 series of books, amounting to 158 books in total.

Keijo Imperial University Library used the “Classification of Japanese-Chinese Books” and the “Classification of European Books” for classification. The Library used the former for classifying East Asian books while the latter was used for classifying Western books. The *Classification of European Books* divided Western books into 22 classes by subject areas and assigned 22 alphabets from A to X (excluding the alphabets “I” and “O” which may be confused with Arabic numbers) to each subject. “A” is for General Works, while “B” for Philosophy and “C” is for Religion, to name a few. This bibliography is based on the books on military & naval sciences, of which the classification numbers start with “X.”

Keijo Imperial University Library added three-digit numbers to the letters that signify the main classes to further classify the sub-topics. For instance, X500 is used for books on Naval science and X900 is used for Red Cross. There are 5 classification numbers for different sub-topics in the *Classification of European Books*. Unlike the Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC), the call numbers in this classification do not clearly show each class and its divisions and sections.

The table of content of this bibliography was arranged in accordance with the *Classification of European Books* and followed the exact categories of that era. We decided to leave the classification as it was and only added the Korean characters so that readers could fully understand the classification structure of the era. The books were also sorted by the classification of that era. Since the classification of books was affected by academic trends of that era, reclassification would be inevitable if these books were to be classified today. The sorting of the books, however, remains as it is for a better understanding of research trends of the period.

The books classified as the same subject were arranged in accordance to the call numbers

of the era. A call number assigned by Keijo Imperial University Library is composed of a classification code made up of a single alphabet letter followed by three-digit numbers, the accession number (given by the accession order of the books) and the edition mark of the book. Moreover, an additional letter is added to the beginning of each call number for documents in special formats. For instance, the call numbers of valuable books begin with “貴” and books that are taller than 30 cm are assigned with call numbers starting with “大.” In other words, the structure of this bibliography follows the arrangement order of books kept at the Rare Books Collections at the library. The following is an example of the call number.

Since this book has an aim to provide the bibliographic information of the library's collection in a more useful format, the bibliographic data in this book was not written in its original form. It also added additional information necessary to fully understand the books such as the number of books in a series, the size of the book and the title of the series (or the titles of individual books). The following is an example of the bibliographic information listed in this bibliography.
